

YOUR VOTING RIGHTS IN VIRGINIA

- **Voter ID.** BRING PHOTO ID. You must provide ID before you will be allowed to vote. Acceptable forms include a Virginia driver's license, Virginia voter registration card, Social Security card, an ID issued by a federal, state or local government agency or an employer ID containing your name and photo.
- **Change of residence.** If you moved within the commonwealth since the last federal election and you were registered to vote at your old address, you may vote at your former polling place if you have not already updated your registration.
- **Clothing, buttons, caps and other accessories.** DO NOT wear campaign materials. The Virginia State Board of Elections interprets state law as prohibiting you from wearing any clothing, button, sticker, cap or other material that supports or opposes a candidate in a polling place or within 40 feet of any entrance of a polling place. You will be asked to remove or cover the material.
- **No-electioneering perimeter.** No electioneering is allowed within 40 feet of the polling place.
