# Bad Trade Agreement

After unsuccessful attempts to bring the Colombia Free Trade Agreement to a vote, it looks like the Bush administration will *demand* a vote before Bush leaves office.

The Colombia FTA represents a continuation of the Bush administration's failed trade policies, an agenda that has contributed to the loss of more than 3 million manufacturing jobs since 2000, skyrocketing trade deficits and shrinking paychecks.

**WRONG for Colombia's Workers**

Colombia remains the most dangerous country in the world for union members—39 trade unionists were murdered in 2007 and another 17 to date in 2008. Of the more than 2,500 murders of trade unionists since 1986, only about 70 cases—about 3 percent—have resulted in convictions.

**No Free Trade With Colombia Until Workers' Rights Are Respected.**
