John Salazar FIGHTS For Working Families



✓ **Protects Workers.** John Salazar voted to fund critical job-training programs for workers whose jobs have been shipped overseas and to protect our jobs from privatization. (H.R. 27, Vote #48, 3/2/05; H.R. 3058, Vote #357, 6/30/05)

✓ **Invests in Education.** John Salazar voted to protect the student loan program, decreasing loan costs for Colorado's students. (S. 1932, 12/19/05)

✓ **Advocates for Affordable Health Care.** John Salazar is fighting for initiatives that will make health care more affordable—including lowering drug prices for Medicare beneficiaries.
