Fights for Affordable Prescription Drugs.

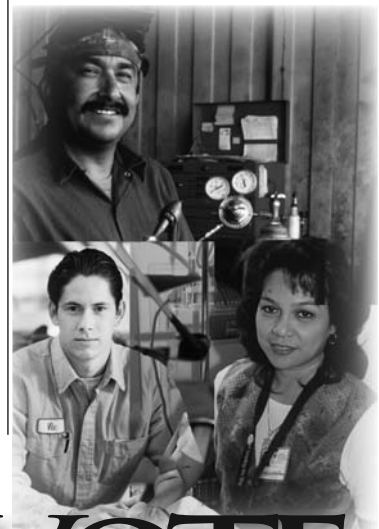
