He has consistently voted against unfair trade agreements like CAFTA, which send our jobs overseas and erode our wages. Supports Our Union Rights. Sen. Akaka co-sponsored the Employee Free Choice Act to protect our freedom to form unions free from employer intimidation. (S. 842, 2005)
