PETER ROSKAM HAS FAILED WORKING FAMILIES

■ **Attacked Our Wages.**

Roskam opposed minimum wage increases and voted to take overtime pay away from Illinois workers. (*Chicago Tribune*, 5/10/06; S.B. 1645, 2004)

■ **Failed on Health Care.**

Roskam voted against the All Kids health care plan, denying health care to our children, and opposed a plan to increase our access to affordable health care. (H.B. 2268, 2004; H.B. 806, 2005)

■ **Slashed Education Funds.**

Roskam denied our public schools \$600 million in new state funding and voted to use public money to fund private education. (S.B. 645, 1997; H.B. 999, 1997)
