STEVE BUYER HAS FAILED WORKING FAMILIES

■ Supports Bad Trade Deals. Steve Buyer voted to send our jobs overseas with CAFTA. He voted for a bill that provided \$40 billion in tax breaks for companies that export jobs and \$140 billion in new corporate tax cuts. He also voted to privatize federal jobs. (H.R. 27, 3/2/05, Vote #628; H.R. 3010, 11/17/05; H.R. 4520, Vote #259, 6/17/04)

■ Increased Costs of Our Health Care. Steve Buyer voted to increase insurance premiums for working families and voted for health care savings accounts that shift costs—and risks—onto workers. He voted for the Medicare prescription drug bill that penalizes our seniors and gives billions to the health care industry, the same industry that has given him almost \$185,000 in campaign contributions. ■ Attacked Our Wages and Benefits. Steve Buyer voted against critical job-training programs, against unemployment benefits for 26,900 Indiana workers and against protecting overtime pay. (H.R. 27, Vote #48, 3/2/05; H.R. 3030, 2/4/04; H.R. 2660, 7/10/03)

Rep. Steve Buyer has a lifetime AFL-CIO congressional voting record of voting **wrong** on working family issues 87 percent of the time.
