

Charlie Wilson FIGHTS For Working Families



✓ **Preserved Our Retirement Security.** Charlie Wilson opposes privatizing Social Security. He knows “Social Security has never been an investment account.” Its intention was “to raise...people over 65 out of poverty.” (*Martins Ferry Times Leader*, 5/31/05)

✓ **Fought for Workers.** Charlie Wilson was the primary sponsor of a bill to help workers who had lost their jobs due to outsourcing enroll in education programs. He voted against a bill that would have blocked workers from getting workers’ compensation payments. (S.B. 7, 6/1/05; S.B. 57, 126th Ohio General Assembly)

✓ **Invested in Education.** Charlie Wilson co-sponsored a bill to improve Ohio’s education system from preschool through college to ensure Ohio maintains a high-quality workforce. (S.B. 6, 1/24/05)



Chuck Blasdel Threatens Workers’ Rights

Chuck Blasdel mandated investment quotas for Ohio’s five public employee retirement systems, costing them as much as \$150 million a year in increased costs and investment losses. He voted to deny collective bargaining rights to employees of the Ohio School Facilities Commission. (*Associated Press*, 4/28/04; *Plain Dealer*, 11/19/03; S.B. 56, 3/15/05)
