Rewarded Companies for Moving Jobs Overseas. Donald Sherwood voted for a bill that provided \$40 billion in tax breaks for companies that export jobs and \$140 billion in new corporate tax cuts. (H.R. 4520, Vote #259, 6/17/04)



Cut Billions from Working Family Programs. Donald Sherwood voted to slash funding for student loans, Medicare, Medicaid, child support enforcement, agricultural programs and assistance for local employers hurt by unfair trade agreements. (S. 1932, Vote #670, 12/19/05)
