

# YOUR VOTING RIGHTS IN LOUISIANA

- **Voter ID. BRING ID.** You need to bring a picture identification card to vote at the polling place. This can be a Louisiana driver's license, a Louisiana Special ID card or other generally recognized picture identification card. If you do not have a picture ID card, you may sign an affidavit, which will be attached to the precinct register, and you will be required to provide further identification as requested by the commissioner at the polling place. If you registered to vote by mail and have not previously voted in a federal election, you must show current and valid photo identification or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows your name and address. You have the right to vote with a provisional ballot if you cannot present valid ID.
- **Change of residence.** If you moved from one precinct to another in the same parish within three months or less of the election, you still have the right to remain a legal registrant in that precinct, as to all issues upon which you were entitled to vote prior to moving. Until you process your registered address or until the three months go by (whichever occurs first), you have the right to vote in the former precinct inside the same parish. If you move to a different parish, you still have the right to vote as to all issues upon which you could vote prior to your change of residence, if within the same three months described above.
- **Clothing, buttons, caps and other accessories.** DO NOT wear any clothes or accessories that contain references to the candidates, parties or political slogans. Such conduct is prohibited by Louisiana law if done within 600 feet of any poll.
- **No-electioneering perimeter.** No electioneering is allowed within 600 feet of the polling place.
