

YOUR VOTING RIGHTS IN NEW HAMPSHIRE

- **Voter ID. BRING ID.** It is always a good idea to have a photo ID when voting. But you must have ID when you are registering on Election Day or if you registered by mail and have not already provided ID. If you registered to vote by mail and have not previously voted in a federal election, you must show current and valid photo identification or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows your name and address. You have the right to vote with a provisional ballot if you cannot present valid ID.
- **Change of residence.** You can register or update your registration at your polling place on Election Day, as long as you can prove your identity, age, residence and citizenship.
- **Clothing, buttons, caps and other accessories.** DO NOT wear campaign materials. To avoid unnecessary delay, make sure you can easily cover or remove any clothing, button, sticker, etc., that supports a candidate or political party. You may not be allowed to vote until such materials are removed or covered.
- **No-electioneering perimeter.** Determined by a moderator at each polling place.
